# Long Answers

#### Part 1

(1) In the future, we will learn from robots. This is one idea in an essay that looks at the science of learning. Here is the idea: humans are born naturally curious, and become creatures capable of highly complex achievements. With new theories about how people learn, robots can be programmed to teach efficiently.

Some robots are now being used to teach skills to preschool children, including the names of colors, new vocabulary words and simple songs.

In the future, robots will be used to teach skills, such as acquiring a new language or possibly in playgroups with children or individual adults. Robot teachers are expected to be cost-effective compared to the expense of paying a human teacher.

(2) Japan is preparing for a jellyfish invasion. The Nomura, also known as the giant jellyfish, can weigh up to 200kg and measure up to 2 meters in diameter. Experts predict large numbers to arrive this year - which could spell disaster for Japan's fishermen.

Six adults can destroy a fishing net, as well as poisoning the fish inside, leaving them inedible. The last time Nomura were seen in Japan's coastal waters was in 2007, fishermen made 15,000 complains about damage to nets.

Japan's Fisheries Agency has warned of several sightings. According to one professor, the arrival of a jellyfish typhoon is inevitable. One firm is planning to cash in on the invasion. Tango Jersey Dairy produces 3,000 cartons of jellyfish ice cream a year, made with chopped Nomura soaked in milk.

(3) China is responsible for most of the world's email spam, according to new research. A US research organization reviewed millions of spam e-mails. Of the total domains reviewed, 70 percent had Internet domains that ended in "cn" — the Chinese country code.

Computer spam refers to unsolicited commercial advertisements distributed online via e-mail, which can sometimes carry viruses and other programs that harm computers.

China has become a safe haven for Web site operators that use spam to promote their products because of the willingness of some Chinese companies to ignore spam complaints. Also, cheap domain names are available in China. Domain names can cost as little as one yuan, or 15 cents in U.S. currency. In contrast, U.S. domain names can costs as much as \$35 a year.
