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Tips and tricks to write like a pro.

Word Power: Nouns

Purpose: Increase the number of words you know, or to help you remember words more quickly.

How to use: For each question, there are three nouns. Add another noun to each word to make three new words. These new words are called compound nouns. Two words come together to make a new noun.

For example, here are three nouns: wash, bed, bath

If we add “room” to each noun, we can make three new words: washroom, bedroom, and bathroom. The new noun can go in front or at the end.
