#### 3 Voice

Your opinions.

Your unique style.



#### 4 Word choice

Good words. Not boring words.

Paint a picture with words.



#### **5** Sentence Fluency

Use a variety of sentences. Long. Short. Different structures.

Good sentences are like musical notes.


They have a beat and rhythm.

Important,, but good writing is more than proper grammar.




#### **6+1 Presentation**
