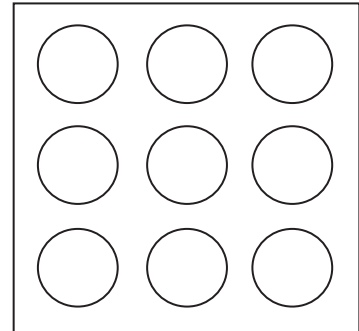


28 EASY GENIUS PUZZLES

146. A LINE OF NUMBERS

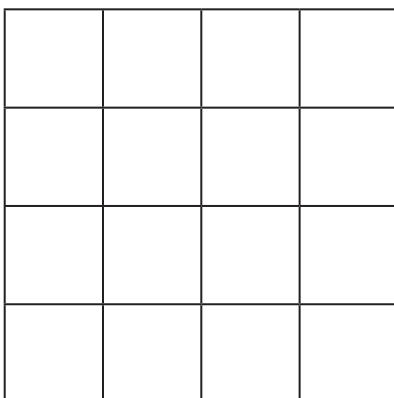
Below is a line of numbers between 1 and 15... except for 4 and 9.
