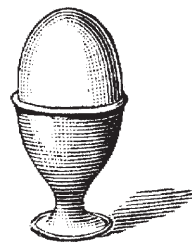

A homophone is a word that has the same pronunciation as another word but a different meaning and usually different spelling. For example, **sun** and **son**. Write one homophone for each word below.

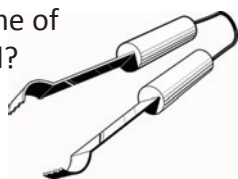
